Ph.D. Registration Process

Admissions for Ph. D. studies are done on 1st of Jan and July every year.

Generally the student discusses the topic with the prospective guide and prepares the proposal. The student submits 5 copies to the Dept sometime in Oct/Nov for January admission and April/May for July admissions.

The student has to present the proposal before the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) set up by the Department. If the committee approves the proposal and finds the candidate suitable the proposal is accepted and sent to RRC (Research and Recognition committee) of the University for approval. RRC is generally held in the last week of June and December (for registration in July and Jan respectively.)

The candidate is expected to work on 4 term papers as suggested by the Guide and submit them within 2 semesters. If the candidate does not have M.Ed. Degree from a recognized university (but has a Master degree from other discipline) then she has to take a bridge course consisting of 2 papers of 100 marks each (System of Education and Research Methodology).

At the end of 2nd semester the candidate presents final proposal for Ph.D. before the DRC. The proposal then is sent to RRC (Research and Recognition committee) for final approval. Once that is approved, the candidate starts working on the research problem. The proposal is sent to Examination department for information.

There are two presentations by the candidate in 1 year. Generally they are done face-to-face.
